Subject: Body Hoists Installed On Specific Units

The body hoists installed on specific Labrie units have to be replaced with new ones. Arrangements have already been made by Phil Hoffman, the North East LabriePlus Field Service Representative.

For safety reasons, specific body hoists shall be replaced with new ones that are known to be built according to specifications. Gland nuts may not have been locked in place with a dowel pin as it should have. A small production lot of body hoist cylinders has been identified and could potentially have "missing dowel pins" on gland nuts.

Serious injuries and/or death could result in the case of a body hoist failure due to gland nuts that could possibly unscrew on their own. The hoists could uncouple. The replacement body hoists shall be installed within (30) days from the date of publication of this bulletin.
