Subject: Emergency Stop Switches

All Labrie multiplexed bodies are equipped with one or more emergency stop switches. They can be found in the cab, on the external controls, and under the panic-bars. They are easy to identify due to their RED color.

These switches have 2 individual NC (Normally Closed) contacts:

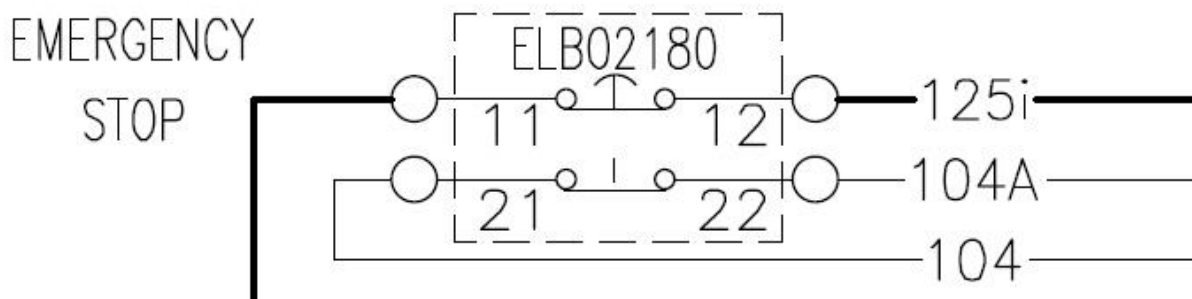
-12V+ system power (wire 104)

-12V+ signal to IFM multiplex diagnostic tool.

The power wires are going in series through all the emergency buttons. This is the typical “interrupt switch” circuit.

The signal wires are different depending on the switch location. This allows our diagnostic tool to show on the IFM display which emergency buttons has been activated.

When pushed in, the contact opens the electrical circuit not allowing the power and signal to go through therefore the system is turned OFF and the display shows you which switch has been triggered.
